Each jumper height will have two different courses over the same jumps; a simple course (S) and a more technical course (T). There will be only one course for each height in the Schooling Derby (cross country jumps mixed with stadium jumps).

Jumper classes will be judged under USEF Table II Section 2 b (jump off on audible signal after completing a clear first round).

Schooling Derby classes will be judged under USEA Stadium Jumping Rules with clear rounds closest to optimum time winning.

El Sueno Equestrian Center Rules and Regulations

1. No smoking in barns, paddocks, corrals, near shavings, manure pile, or anywhere else where there is combustible material.
2. No ATVs, motorcycles, bicycles, skateboards, etc. are allowed within the facilities.
3. Please deposit trash in designated trash barrels.
4. Riders, trainers, grooms, and spectators must be respectful to the boarders on the property and stay within designated competition areas.
5. Please use designated competition restrooms and not restrooms in the barn.
6. All exhibitors, trainers, and guests are expected to exhibit good sportsmanship.
7. All participants must sign a hold harmless agreement.
8. El Sueno and, or Riverview Pony Club reserves the right to limit or revoke participation to anyone at any time.
9. Exhibitors are to compete at their own risk.
10. All riders must wear SEI approved head gear at all times while mounted on the grounds.
11. Lunging is allowed only in designated areas.
12. Please park only in designated areas.
13. Children must be under adult supervision at all times.
14. Dogs must be on leashes at all times. Please pick up after your dog!
15. Loose children and dogs may be claimed by payment of \$100 fine.
2. Entry form must be completed in its entirety.
3. El Sueno Release must be signed by everyone.
4. USPC Non-Member release must be signed by non-members.
5. Enter by email or by mail. If mailing, mail forms Open checks or credit card must be given to Office before receiving number!
6. A signed open check must be deposited with the Show Secretary before numbers are issued.
7. Exhibitors are encouraged to close their accounts in person. Management will close exhibitor accounts that have not been settled at the conclusion of the competition. Billing questions or refunds will not be considered.
8. Competition policies herein stated regarding scratches and refunds will be followed regardless of weather.
9. CLASS ADD / SCRATCH / CHANGE
 - a. Scratch must be made in writing to the office or announcer before a class begins.
 - b. Adds may be made in writing to the office or announcer before the class ends.
10. Combining, dividing, or cancelling divisions or classes will be made at the discretion of the management. A minimum of two riders are required for a class to be held, otherwise it will be cancelled or combined.
11. Refunds will only be given if management cancels a class.
12. \$50 penalty will be assessed for returned checks.
13. Riders arriving Friday may ride on the flat in the Derby field, but may not school obstacles.

Camino Real Region Entry Policies and Procedure

Conditions

Every class offered herein will be run by the rules and specifications of the current United States Equestrian Federation Rule Book.

Competition Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regards to, or arising out of, or incident to the competition without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by Competition Management; its decision is final.

Schooling Derby Classes

Schooling Derby classes are stand alone derby jumping courses, clear rounds closest to optimum time will win. Derby courses consist of obstacles commonly found on USEA Eventing courses, including banks, coffins, water, and uneven ground appropriate for the level as well as stadium jumps.

Jumper classes will use USEF Table II Section 2b, (Jump off on hearing audible signal after completing clear first round)

I HEREBY EXPRESSLY, VOLUNTARILY, AND UNCONDITIONALLY RELEASE, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS El Sueno Equestrian Center, Deborah Rosen and/or Wild Ride Eventers, their owners, officers, members, agents, employees, licensees and invitees, as well as any other person, firm, corporation, company, entity, or anyone in any way connected with the ownership and management of the show premises and the Horse Show, or in control of the premises or equipment related thereto (collectively, "Releasees") from and against ANY AND ALL CLAIMS FOR INJURIES, DAMAGES, AND/OR LOSSES connected with participation in the Horse Show. This includes, but is not limited to, claims for monetary damages, attorney's fees, costs, losses, and/or causes of action against Releasees for any and all HARM to me or my horse(s) and for any HARM caused or contributed in any way to by me or my horse(s) to others, arising out of or in any way connected with participation in the Horse Show, and includes reimbursement of Releasees' costs and attorney's fees incurred in defense of such claims. I further agree to this release, indemnification, and holding harmless WHETHER OR NOT SUCH CLAIM, INJURY, DAMAGE, OR LOSS RESULTED, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, FROM MY NEGLIGENCE ACTS OR OMISSIONS OF THE NEGLIGENCE ACTS OR OMISSIONS OF RELEASEES, to the fullest extent allowed by law. GENERAL ACTIVITY RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER OF LIABILITY, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

FOR USPC NON-MEMBERS

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE for myself, and/or my child, my/our administrators and assigns, in consideration for my, and/or my child's, participation in this United States Pony Clubs, Inc. (USPC) activity to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in an USPC activity, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, spectator, volunteer, and/or trainer. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and USPC activities involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including, but not limited to, broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering or death ("Harm"). I fully understand that this release covers, but is not limited to, inherent risks of an equine activity which mean a danger or condition that is an integral part of an equine activity, including but not limited to, any of the following: The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death, or loss to persons on or around the equine; The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals; Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions; A collision with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object; The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other persons, including but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant.

I AGREE to release the USPC, its successors or assigns, officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations from all claims including, but not limited to, claims for money or property, disability, covenants, actions, suits, causes or action, obligations, debts, costs, expenses, attorneys' fees, judgments, orders and liabilities of whatsoever kind or nature in law, equity or otherwise, whether now known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, and whether concealed or hidden, including but not limited to any state or federal statutory or common law claim or remedy of any kind whatsoever arising out of or in any way connected with any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the USPC or the USPC activity.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the USPC or the USPC activity, and specifically agree to the applicable state statute/law regarding equine/farm animal activity liability and signed posting (if any), in any state in which I or my child participates in a USPC activity. A true copy for all state statutes in effect at the time of the execution of this agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as if set out fully in the text of this document.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the USPC, the USPC activity, and the Ventura County Fairgrounds and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse in the USPC activity.

I AGREE that neither I, nor any one claiming through me, will hereafter bring, commence, prosecute or maintain, or cause or permit to be brought, commenced, prosecuted or maintained, any suit or action, either at law or in equity, in any court in the United States or in any state thereof, or elsewhere, against the USPC, the El Sueno Equestrian Center, their successors or assigns, for, on account of, arising out of, or in any way connected with any Harm to me or my horse, and that neither I, nor any one claiming through me, will enforce, prosecute, or recover upon, or attempt to enforce, prosecute, or recover upon, any claim or right of action whatsoever, which I, or any one claiming through me, may now have or hereafter assert, in any way connected with claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harms caused by me or my horse at the USPC activity.

I AGREE this Agreement is the entire agreement of the parties, and supersedes all prior oral and written understandings and agreements. This Agreement may be modified only by a written amendment signed by both parties.

I AGREE that if any provision of the Agreement is found to be invalid or illegal by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall be construed as if the affected provision had not been included in order to effectuate the intent of the parties.

In the event this form is signed by the parent/guardian of a child, then all representations and acknowledgements herein are expressly made by, for, and on behalf of the parent/guardian and child.

By signing below, I AGREE to be bound by all applicable USPC rules and all terms and provisions of the USPC activity. I acknowledge that I enter into this release after having read the same, and place my signature hereto of my own free voluntary act and deed. By signing below, I represent to the USPC that I fully understand its contents, that I do not need any further explanation, and I waive any further explanation.
